Students intending to complete a baccalaureate degree in LEJA from WIU should follow the Associate in Science degree program outlined in this brochure from Southeastern Community College.

Students who complete the Associate's degree at Southeastern Community College, and who earn a GPA of at least 2.5 may transfer to WIU and complete their degree in Law Enforcement and Justice Administration in an additional two years.
