

**Plan of Study for Transfer Students
Southeastern Iowa Community College**

For students planning to transfer to UNI and major in Social Work, the following plan of study is generally recommended:

1. Complete an Associate of Arts (A.A.) at Southeastern Iowa Community College
2. Complete the of the following courses at Southeastern Iowa Community College (as electives within the A.A. degree)

Complete a cultures class at Southeastern Community College to satisfy the Non-Western Cultures requirement at UNI. Take ONE of the following:

Latin American History/Culture (CLS 150) or Modern Asian History (HIS 211)

NOTES FROM AN ADVISOR:

All prospective social work majors are highly encouraged to complete a General Biology, Intro to Biology or Human Biology course prior to transferring.

AND

Students who take Southeastern Community College courses that transfer in as equivalents for UNI PSYCH, FAM SERV, SOC or CRIM courses can complete a Student Request form with their UNI Social Work Advisor for consideration for that course to count as a UNI Social Work Elective. The UNI Social Work major requires 2-3 SW Electives as part of the degree.
