Transfer students who have earned an Associate of Arts degree (AA) from a two-year institution with an articulation agreement with the University of Iowa will enter the University having fulfilled all the General Education Program requirements for the Colleges of Liberal Arts & Sciences and Education, with the exception of the world language requirement and the Diversity and Inclusion requirement.

If you have not completed the foreign language requirement of a four year sequence of one foreign language while in high school, it is strongly recommended that you complete it a SCC by taking a two year sequence of one foreign language.

Transfer students must complete the following courses at the University of Iowa before they can student teach: Technology in the Classroom (EDTL:3002), Orientation to Elementary Education (EDTL:3190), a practicum, and two of the following: Reading and Responding to Children’s Literature, (EDTL:3123), Literacy Learning and Teaching I (EDTL:3160), Social Studies for the Elementary Classroom Teacher (EDTL:3161), Methods: Elementary School Mathematics (EDTL:3163), Literacy Learning and Teaching II (EDTL:3164).

Application Deadlines for University of Iowa:

Deadlines to apply to the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences:
April 1—for Fall Semester (March 1 for international applicants)
October 15—for Spring Semester (October 1 for international applicants)
April 1—for Summer Session (March 1 for international applicants)

Deadlines to apply to the Teacher Education Program:
October 1—for spring
March 1—for summer or fall
